This year, our school continue to partner with the Education University of Hong Kong to carry out "Social-Emotional Project". We also participate in "Thematic Network on Positive Education for Whole Child Development" — Online Schoolbased Parent Workshop organised by Chinese University of Hong Kong. We developing school-based are positive emotions curriculum, so as to allow children to understand different emotions and coping skills from games, to strengthen children's minds, to train children' perseverance to face evolving environment, and to lay the foundation for a positive life.







Montessori Education






This year, our school set up Montessori classrooms based on the characteristics of Montessori teaching. These include Daily Life Area, Sensory Area, Mathematics Area, Language Area, Cultural Area and Art Area, and added Montessori classrooms. In line with the features of each area, we also incorporate Montessori teaching materials. In their own classrooms, children also have the opportunity to be exposed to learning activities in different areas. Teachers set "teaching priorities" based on children's progress and interests. Teachers also change the teaching materials regularly, and arrange them neatly and orderly, so that children can choose what they want to work on. This help to develop children's autonomy and self-discipline.

Language Development Thematic Story & Picture Book Project Teaching















In the "Little Li rides a tricycle" Picture Book Project, children learnt different modes of transportation and roads in Hong Kong through exploration and observation. Among the many means of transportation, children are particularly interested in bicycles. They asked curiously questions, such as "Is my bicycle a means of transportation?", "Can we ride a bicycle on the road?" With a view to let children have a deeper understanding of bicycle, teachers and children used the picture book story "Little Li Rides A Tricycle" as the support for the project, and it conducted a series of study activities.

During the project learning, children explored and learnt about bicycles step by step. Children developed different layers of understanding about bicycle: from the structure and the types of bicycle to the history and rules of riding bicycle, and even the functions of the wheels. Through different activities, we enable children to develop their characteristics in the moral, intellectual, physical, social and aesthetic domains.

Viruses are everywhere and we often encounter them in our daily lives. If we are not careful, they will affect our health.

Through the story book "Say Bye Bye to Coronavirus!", children learnt about the source of the virus. Since they were experiencing the epidemic in person, their living habits, learning styles and personal hygiene were impacted in varying degrees. Children carried out different exploration activities, explored the source of the virus and prevention methods during the project. They also developed their observation skills and awareness of maintaining good hygiene.

















"Turtle" is the most accessible animal in daily life. The story book "Turtle with its shell thrown away" engaged the children and allowed them to actively share their knowledge of turtles and the experience of raising one. The children were full of curiosity about the cute turtles. The teacher supported their learning with use of story books and inspired the children to explore and understand "turtle" in different directions. Children learnt to express their own discoveries, recognize the wonders of nature, and cultivate the importance of caring for nature in daily life.

The children gained a deep understanding of the concepts related to "turtle", like types, living habits and growth of "turtle" through different activities such as data collection, observation and care. They learnt the importance of protecting "turtles" and cultivated a positive attitude of caring for nature.

Through the activity of "Turtle Visit", children furthered their learning by learning about the characteristics and habitats of different types of turtles. It enriched children's understanding of turtles.







2nd school term (5-6 years old)

Due to the pregnancy of several parents, the children observed that the pregnant mother's belly were getting bigger and bigger. They were amazed at the birth of a new life. They often asked their friends and teachers questions like "Did we live in our mother's belly before we were born?" In response to the interest of the children, the teacher and the children chose the story book "Doctor Anton Welcomes the Baby" to support the children's learning. It enabled the children to understand the lives of different species, and to think and discuss through activities. Children recognized their own uniqueness, and learnt to accept, cherish, respect themselves and others.

















Cultivation of arts and crafts is also an important part of whole-person development. Therefore, our school also provides children with a variety of cultural and artistic activities every day, including creative arts, music, dance and drama, to promote the comprehensive and balanced development of children.













The children's art course covers the concepts of color, point and line, surface and texture, three-dimensional and two-dimensional, so as to allow children to develop different creative skills and attitudes of appreciation and respect.















In this year, our school will hold a "Creative Art Exhibition for Young Children" for senior children. This online exhibition allows the public to see the unique works of young children no matter where they are.

In drama activities, children play different roles and develop their creativity in a space of free expression.








Physical Fitness

In addition to a daily PE session, the school also promotes children's comprehensive motor skills, including stability, mobility and operation skills through weekly spiral teaching. It aims to improves children's muscular endurance, balance, and jumping ability. trainings These enable young children to develop the concept of health from an early age.

Montessori Training

Our senior teacher, Ling Wing Sze, has training sessions. completed the "International Montessori Master's Course". She has conducted Montessori training with teachers that teachers regularly so understand the concept and application of Montessori which promotes children's self-discipline and autonomy through self-operation of teaching materials.



STEM Trainin

STEM teaching has become an indispensable field in recent years. In order to broaden teachers' vision, Hong Jinhua, Professor of Hong Kong Baptist University conducted training and class observations with our teachers regularly. Teachers can further understand different STEM concepts and lay the foundation for the development of STEM curriculum

Home-School Collaboration

Parents are important partners of the school. For parents to have a clear understanding of the school's development direction and to cooperate with teachers, the school displays learning logs, announcements, monthly updates of activity photos in the lobby and on E-school every day. Parents can keep track of their child's growth and learning.

Parents can also exchange information with the school through parent representative groups or through daily interviews, phone calls, emails or handbooks, and devote themselves to their children's school life together. They can even join the alumni association after graduation to maintain friendships.

In addition, the school has continued to have school social workers this year to address the needs of families and provide professional support.













Parents also connect with the school through various activities and courses organized by the school, such as Ocean Park Play Day, Parent-Child Yoga Day, and festival celebrations to support the growth of their children.

Future Development

The school has been in operation for five academic years. This year, with the professional support from the Education University of Hong Kong's "3Es Emotion + Social Partnership Program" and the Chinese University of Hong Kong's "QEF Thematic Network on Positive Education for Whole Child Development", the school will continue adopting the school-based positive character cultivation strategy. At the same time, with senior teacher, Ms. Ling's advanced studies in the "International Montessori Master's Program", a Montessori classroom was set up, and teachers were able to understand the relevant teaching concepts.

In the coming year, our school will also receive support from the Education Bureau's "On-site Professional Support Service - Cultivating Children's Positive Values and Attitudes Project" and will continue to nurture children's positive values and attitudes through positive emotional and social activities. In addition, the school will establish a Montessori teaching environment and strengthen teachers' skills in observing and recording children's behavior, so as to improve children's self-care and self-learning ability according to their individual progress, and to cultivate children's autonomy, self-discipline and respect for society.
